Ordinance No 7
Ordinance Regulating Dray License
Any and all persons owning or operating a
dray within the limits of said village shall
pay into the village treasurer the sum of
five \$5.00 dollars and said sum for such license
shall again become due and payable on the
first day May of each succeeding year.
And any person violating the provisions
of said section shall be deemed guilty
of misdemeanor.

ORDINANCE NO. 7.

Ordinance regulating Dray license and Dog
tax of the Village of Shelly.

Any and all persons owning or operating a
dray within the limits of said Village shall pay
into the Village treasurer the sum of \$5.00
(five dollars) and said sum for license shall
again become due and payable on the first
day of each succeeding year.

And any person violating the provisions of
said section shall be deemed guilty of Mis-
demeanor.

ORDINANCE NO. 8.

All persons within the corporate limits of
said village owning or harboring a male dog
shall pay into the village treasurer on or be-
fore the first day of May the sum of \$1 (one dol-
lar).

Sec. 2. Any person owning or harboring a
female dog shall pay into the village treasur-
er the sum of \$1.50 (one dollar and fifty cents)
as a license fee. After the first day of May
of each year the Village Marshal or Constable
of said village shall destroy all dogs who's
owner or harborer have failed to pay such li-
cense as aforesaid.
