

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE RUNNING OF DOGS AT LARGE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SHELLEY DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Running at Large Prohibited. No dog or dog-like creature nor cat nor cat-like creature shall be permitted to run at large within the limits of the City of Shelly. This restriction does not prohibit the appearance of any dog, dog-like creature, cat, or cat-like creature upon the streets or public property when the animal is on a leash and is kept under the control of the person charged with its care.

Section 2. The owner or custodian of any dog, dog-like creature, cat, or cat-like creature shall prevent the animal from committing, in the City, any act which constitutes a nuisance. It is a nuisance for any such animal to habitually or frequently bark or cry at night, to frequent school grounds or parks, or chase vehicles, to molest or annoy any person away from the property of his owner or custodian, or to damage, defile, or destroy public or private property. Failure of the owner or custodian of said animal to prevent said animal from committing such a nuisance is a violation of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating the terms or provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

Section 4. This Ordinance supersedes any prior inconsistent Ordinance or provisions thereof. This Ordinance does not supersede any prior Ordinances relating to the licensing or impoundment or destruction or muzzling of animals or the cost of impoundment of any such animal.
