

ORDINANCES, RULES, REGULATIONS, AND BY-LAWS

of the Village of Shelly, Norman County, Minn.

Ordinance No. 2.

An ordinance to provide for the manner of constructing sidewalks and crosswalks in the village of Shelly.

The village council of the village of Shelly do ordain as follows:

Section 1. All sidewalks in said village or McKinley Avenue running from railroad right of way west to Johnson street and from railroad right of way to Johnson's paint shop and Foss and Hortel's store east; shall be eight (8) feet in width and constructed of two inch pine planks and shall be set and firmly spiked upon four (4) sleepers or stringers of pine two (2) inches thick and six (6) inches wide, placed edgewise two (2) feet five (5) inches apart from centers and four (4) inches from the sides of the walk respectively, and to be placed upon a firm foundation.

The sides of the walk towards the center of street must be eight (8) feet from sides of street.

Section 2. All other sidewalks in said village to be hereafter built or repaired, unless hereafter specially ordered, shall be four (4) feet wide and constructed of two inch pine planks and shall be set and firmly spiked upon three (3) sleepers or stringers of pine two (2) inches thick and six (6) inches wide, placed edgewise one (1) foot eight (8) inches apart from centers and four (4) inches from side of the walk respectively, and to be placed upon a firm foundation. The sides of the walk towards the center of street must be four (4) feet from the sides of the street.

Section 3 No sidewalks not constructed in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance, shall be accepted by the street commissioner or other officers of said village, unless otherwise specially ordered by the council.

Section 4 This ordinance shall be in force on and after its passage.
