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Ordinance No. 15

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A BOARD OF HEALTH, DEFINING ITS POWERS AND DUTIES.

The village council of Shelly do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Board of Health Created. A village board of health of three members, to be appointed by the council at its first meeting following any regular election for members of said council, is hereby created.

Sec. 2. Health Officer. One member of said board of health shall be a physician, who shall be the executive of the board, and village health officer.

Sec. 3. Duty of Board of Health. It shall be the duty of the board of health to make such investigations and reports and obey such directions concerning communicable diseases as the state department of health may require or give, and to cause all statutes, ordinances, and lawful rules and regulations concerning public health to be enforced and obeyed.

Sec. 4. Duty of Health Officer. It shall be the duty of the village health officer to execute the lawful orders of the state and village boards of health and to perform such other duties as are or may be prescribed by statute, or by regulation of the state board of health.

Sec. 5. Control of Communicable Diseases. The village health officer shall employ at the expense of the village such medical and other help as may be necessary in the control of communicable diseases. All statements of expense incurred in establishing, enforcing, and releasing quarantine shall, after payment, be certified to the county auditor for allowance of one-half the amount by the county board to the village as provided by law. No such expense shall be paid by the village unless payment by the person or persons liable therefor cannot be enforced.
