Ordinance No. 12,

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PENNING UP OF POULTRY, in the Village of Shelly, Minnesota .----

The Village Council of the Village of Shelly, Minnesota, do ordian as follows :-----

Section One .

All persons, within the corporate limits of the said Village of Shelly, owning poultry, shall be compelled to keep their poultry penned or fenced in on their own premises and not allow them to run on the Streets or Highways in the said Village of Shelly. ---

Section Two .

Any person violating the provissions of Section One shall upon convictions thereof be fined not less than Five Dollars in each offence and the cost of prosecution, and if default of the payment thereof be committed to the village jail for a length of time not exceeding sixty days .----

Section Three.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication.----

Passed and adopted by the Village Counvil of the Village of Shelly, Minnesota, this 12th. day of July, A.D. 1915 .-----

An ordinance regulating Motion Pictures Shows , Vaudeville Shows, Medicine Shows and peddlers.

The Village Council of the village of Shelly, Minn. do ordain as follows

- Sec.1. Any itinerant person or persons or company staging a motion picture show in the said village ,shall first obtain a license and pay a license fee of two dollars per day into the village treasury.
- Sec.2. Any person or persons conducting a motion picture show and selling medicine in conjunction therewith in the said village ~~of~~ shall first obtain a license and pay a license fee of five dollars per day.
- Sec.3. Any person or persons conducting a vaudeville show in the said village shall first obtain a license and pay a license fee of three dollars per day.
- Sec.4. Any peddler or itinerant merchant shall before vending his goods in the said village ,obtain a license and pay a license fee of three dollars per day.
- Sec.5. Any person or persons violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars, or by imprisonment in the County jail not to exceed 20 days.
- Sec.6. This ordinance to take effect ~~and~~ on and after its passage.
