Be it Ordained by the Village Council of the Village of Shelly in the County of Norman, State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to the STANDARD OIL COMPANY, a corporation, organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana, to construct and maintain for a term of Twenty (20) years, upon the following described property, to-wit:-

A parcel of land 50 feet by 100 feet on the Great Northern right of way adjoining the Shelly Stock & Lumber Company on the south side, 203 feet north of the south Head Block Switch and running south 50 feet along the right of way,

warehouse, tanks and other buildings necessary for its business, and to store therein illuminating oils, coal oils, naptha, gasoline, and other mineral oils or fluids, the products of Petroleum in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of its said business.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect on and after its passage and acceptance in writing by the said STANDARD OIL COMPANY.
