

ORDINANCES, RULES, REGULATIONS, AND BY-LAWS

of the Village of Shelly, Norman County, Minn.

Ordinance No. 3.

An Ordinance to Prevent the Increase of Fire Risks.

The village council of the village of Shelly, do ordain as follows.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to place, put or deposit within the limits of this village, on either public or private premises, any straw, hay, shavings or other inflammable or combustible material within three (300) hundred feet of any dwelling house or other building, except same be inclosed within a building, without first obtaining permission therefor from the council of said village.

Section 2. Any person offending against the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof pay a fine of, not less than ten (10) dollars nor more than fifty (50) dollars and costs of prosecution, or be punished by imprisonment in the village jail for a length of time not exceeding sixty (60) days.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect at, and from its passage and publication.

ORDINANCE NO. 3.
A N ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE INCREASE OF FIRE RISKS.
 The Village Council of the Village of Shelly, do ordain as follows:
SECTION I:—That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons place, put or deposit within the limits of the village, on either public or private premises, any straw, hay, shavings or other inflammable or combustible material within three (300) hundred feet of any dwelling house or other building, except same be enclosed within a building, without first obtaining permission from the village council of said village.
SECTION II:—Any person or persons offending against the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof pay a fine of not less than ten (10) dollars, nor more than fifty (50) dollars and costs of prosecution, or be punished by imprisonment in the village jail for a length of time not exceeding sixty (60) days.
SECTION III:—This ordinance shall take effect at and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 4.
A N ORDINANCE REGULATING SLAUGHTERING HOUSES.
 The Village Council of the Village of Shelly, do ordain as follows:
SECTION I:—That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to operate or maintain a slaughtering house or houses or kill any domestic animals for human food within sixty (60) rods from any dwelling house in the Village of Shelly or any public highway, street or avenue in said village.
SECTION II:—Any person or persons offending against the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof pay a fine of not less than five (5) dollars nor more than twenty-five (25) dollars and costs of prosecution; or in lieu thereof, be imprisoned not less than five (5) days nor more than fifteen (15) days.
SECTION III:—This ordinance to take effect on and after its passage.

ORDINANCE NO. 5.
A N ORDINANCE REGULATING POOL TABLES.
 The Village Council of the Village of Shelly do ordain as follows:
SECTION I:—That it shall be unlawful for any person or keepers of any pool room to keep such room or rooms open for playing purposes, or permit any playing on said table, or tables after eleven o'clock p. m., nor before six o'clock a. m. each evening and morning except Sundays, when said table or tables shall be covered at eleven o'clock p. m. Saturday evening, with a cloth spread, sufficiently to hide it from view, and remain so covered during the sabbath until six o'clock a. m. Monday morning.
SECTION II:—That it shall be unlawful for any proprietor or keeper of any saloon, room, restaurant, or public place of amusement within the village of Shelly to suffer or permit any minor to play pool or billiards in any such place owned, occupied or managed by him.
SECTION III:—Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not less than ten (10) dollars, nor more than fifty (50) dollars, or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed thirty (30) days and costs of prosecution and have the license revoked and forfeit the proportionate remainder of the license fee.
SECTION IIII:—This ordinance to take effect and be in force on and after its passage and publication.
