The Village in Incit of the Village of Shelly

"Secritor I:—That it shall be unlawful for
any person or keepers of any podlorom to
keep such room or rooms open for playing
purposes, or permit any playing on said
table, or ables after eleven o'clock p. m., nor
before six o'clock a. m. each evening and
morning except Sundays, when said table or
tables shall be covered at eleven o'clock p. m.
Saturday evening, with a cloth spread, sufficiently to hide it from view, and remain so
covered during the sabbath until six o'clock
a. m. Monday morning.

Sectron III—That it shall be unlawful for
any propeletor or keeper of any saloon, room,
restaurant, or public place of amusement
within the village of Shelly to suffer or permit any minor to play pool or billiards in any
such place owned, occupied or managed by

Sectron III:—Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance,
