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Ordinance No. 16

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE CLEANING OF PREMISES, ESTABLISHING
A SANITARY INSPECTION.

The village council of Shelly do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The street commissioner shall, under the direction of the health officer, make a thorough sanitary inspection of all public and private property in the village in the month of May of each year and present a written report of such inspection to the health officer. The health officer shall transmit the report together with his recommendations to the village council on or before the first day of June. A copy of the health officer's report shall also be sent, on or before July 1, to the State Department of Health.

Section 2. Preceding the May sanitary inspection the health officer shall cause a notice to be posted in three public places in the village, ordering persons thoroughly to clean all yards, vaults, cesspools, sheds, and barns and to cause all tin cans, trash and manure to be removed therefrom on or before the first day of May. If, upon inspection, such order has not been complied with as to any lot or parcel of ground, individual orders requiring owners or occupants of such premises to clean the same, shall be issued by the marshal and a reinspection made of such premises on or before May 15.

Section 3. Any person who shall fail to comply with any reasonable order made under the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.
